Timeline for Jamboree

Sunday, July 11-

Event Center in Kearney, south of I-80, bring your loaded foot locker, personalized chair, and sleeping bag to be loaded onto a trailer which will be at Jamboree when we get there

Friday, July 23-

Meet at St. Paul's United Methodist Church, 324 South Jackson in Papillion

Saturday, July 24-

Go by bus to airport. Your only luggage will be your day pack. Fly to Washington, DC. Tour. Stay in hotel.

Sunday, July 25-

Tour. Stay in hotel.

Monday, July 26-

Tour. Go to Fort AP Hill

Tuesday, July 27-Tuesday August 3 JAMBOREE

Wednesday, August 4-

Leave Fort AP Hill. Tour. Fly to Omaha. Go by bus to Camp Augustine.

August 8-

Pick up footlocker at the Event Center

On your Jamboree uniform, you may wear your OA flap and rank badge. Do not bring your merit badge sash. If you are in the OA, bring that sash.

On Sunday, **July 11**, you are to bring your footlockers, sleeping bags and chairs to the Kearney Event Center located south of I-80 from 3:00-4:00 pm. Tyson Coble and Chris Bolton will be hauling our equipment out to the jamboree. They are both on the jamboree staff. If you cannot be there at that time, please call Scoutmaster Mowry at his home at 308-237-2059 to make arrangements with him.

On Friday, **July 23rd**, we are meeting at St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Papillion. The address is 324 South Jackson in Papillion. Eat your evening meal before you get there. Arrive between 5:00 and 8:00 pm. Come in your Class A uniform. We will hand out neckerchiefs, slides and hats that evening.

Don't forget your photo ID. You will need it to get into National Jamboree.

You will need to bring cash to buy council strips for trading. They will be \$3 each



When packing your day pack, all your liquids and gels must be in a 3 ounce or smaller plastic container, and placed in a one quart clear plastic zip loc bag. You will be asked to remove the bag from your day pack when going through airport security.

Do not pack anything sharp. This includes pocket knives and fingernail clippers. For more regulations, go to www.tsa.gov for the Transportation Security Administration rules.

Be sure to pack your extra uniform and uniform socks in your day pack. The only other clothing you will need in your day pack will be undies and something comfortable to sleep in.
