Timeline for Jamboree

Sometime in July (date and place to be determined), you will bring your loaded footlocker, personalized chair, and sleeping bag to be loaded onto a trailer which will be at Jamboree when we get there
Friday, July 23- meet in Omaha (place to be determined)
Saturday, July 24- Go by bus to airport. Your only luggage will be your day pack.
Fly to Washington, DC. Tour. Stay in hotel.
Sunday, July 25- Tour. Stay in hotel.
Monday, July 26-Tour. Go to Fort AP Hill
Tuesday, July 27 through Tuesday August 3- JAMBOREE
Wednesday, August 4- Leave Fort AP Hill. Tour. Fly to Omaha. Go by bus to Camp Augustine.
Pick up footlocker (date and place to be determined)

When packing, all your liquids and gels must be in a 3 ounce or smaller plastic container, and placed in a one quart clear plastic zip loc bag. You will be asked to remove the bag from your day pack when going through airport security.

Do not pack anything sharp. This includes pocket knives and fingernail clippers. For more regulations, go to www.tsa.gov for the Transportation Security Administration rules.

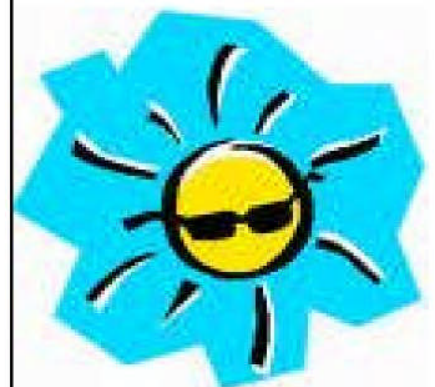
