Scouts and Parents:

While we are hoping for a fun and safe Jamboree experience, it is prudent to be prepared for an emergency. The Council and National have each put together plans for contacting families if necessary.

The Council plan is based around a “phone tree” and is posted on the Council website under the Jamboree link. At the bottom of that page are two important links: Emergency Phone Tree and Important Contact Numbers. By contacting just five Principle callers, the remaining Troop families can be contacted in a rapid and efficient manner. However, the Phone Tree is only as good as its information. Please take a minute and check to be sure your phone information is correct. If you find wrong numbers or old numbers, please contact the Principle caller for your group and let them know the correct information. The “Important Contact Numbers” link has phone numbers for Dave Plond, Mike Tye (Troop Committee Chairman) and the Scoutmasters.

The National plan, called the “2010 National Scout Jamboree Mass Notification System”, is based on multiple means of communication. You should have received information from National on how to register with them. Our recommendation is that you take the time and register for this notification. As much information you can get in the case of an emergency is probably the best way to stay informed of the situation. Also, having two separate systems makes it more likely you will receive important information.
