Timeline for Jamboree

Don't forget your photo ID. You will need it to get into National Jamboree.

Be sure to turn in your prescription medications to one of the scoutmasters when you get to Papillion on Friday.



In the past, some of the equipment has been offered for sale after jamboree. If you or your troops are in need of tents or cots, it would be a good way to get them at a reduced price.

When packing your day pack, all your liquids and gels must be in a 3 ounce or smaller plastic container, and placed in a one quart clear plastic zip loc bag. You will be asked to remove the bag from your day pack when going through airport security.

Do not pack anything sharp. This includes pocket knives and fingernail clippers. For more regulations, go to www.tsa.gov for the Transportation Security
