Health Forms

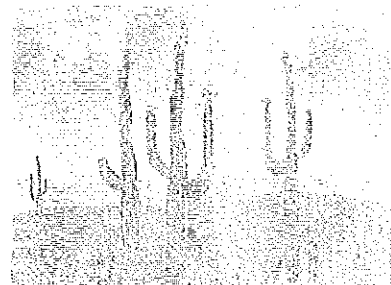

The Scouts should wear comfortable clothing: shoes or sneakers with socks must be worn. Flip flops, sandals or opened-toed shoes are not allowed.
