What is Fun With Son?

- Designed for boys who will be in 1st grade in fall of 2010
- An introduction to Scouting at Camp Augustine with crafts, archery, bb guns, campfire, leather-craft, and much more!
- Two days, one night adventure
- Created for a Cub Scout and adult partner (other family members cannot stay)
- Saturday check-in 1:00 p.m.; Sunday check-out 11:30 a.m.
- Meals served - Saturday night dinner, Sunday morning breakfast

How do we register?

Registrations are taken as a Pack, not individually. Contact your Pack Committee Chair or Den Leader to get registered. Pack registration form, money, and Tour Permit should be mailed together.

What is the cost?

The cost is \$30 per youth and adult for the early bird fee if postmarked by April 28th. After April 28th the fee is \$50.

Are T-shirts and patches available?

Every youth will receive a limited-edition patch celebrating 100 years of Scouting in the Wild West. T-shirts must be ordered by April 28 at a cost of \$12 each. After April 28 they will be available at Camp in limited sizes and quantities.

What about health forms?

Every Scout and adult attending Fun with Son needs a health form filled out, parts A and C only, and turned in at camp when you arrive. **Do not** send these in when you register.

What about Tour Permits?

Each Pack needs to complete a Tour Permit and send it with the registration information even if each parent is bringing their own child.

Can other family members or non-Scouts attend camp?

The only people who can attend Fun with Son are a registered Cub Scout and his adult partner..

A parent in my pack can't go, can I bring their son?

Each boy must have their parent or legal guardian with them who is at least 18 years of age. If you have questions contact the Scout Office.

Trading Post:

In the trading post you can purchase many Scouting supplies, t-shirts, pocket knives, toys, etc. You can also purchase some snack foods, slushies, ice cream, candy, etc. Cots are also available in the trading post and are available on a first come basis for a nominal rental fee.

Check-in Procedures

Please designate one person to be in charge of check-in. This individual turns in all health forms and tour permit for the pack.. After checking in, one vehicle per unit will be allowed into the campsite to drop off the entire units gear and then return to the parking lot. Vehicles are not allowed in the campsites permanently and youth are not allowed to be in vehicles coming into camp unless they are in a seatbelt. If someone within your group will be arriving late or departing early, they will need to check-in or check-out at the Trading Post.

What is each campsite equipped with?

Tents are on wooden platforms, 12 inches off the ground, that hold two people or three small boys. Each campsite has a fire ring, running water, and latrine. Bring a bucket for water if you plan to start a fire. The camp has a communal shower house separated for women, men, and boys.

What can I expect at Camp

Camp Augustine supplies all the food, the tents (unless you indicated that you would bring your own), and the program. Our facility is top notch and we are proud to show it off. Our entire staff is made up of volunteers and they are dedicated to making this camping experience a great one for you and your son!

What to bring to Camp:

A general rule of thumb is to only bring what you can carry; it's only an overnight campout.

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Comfortable clothes for 2 days and 1 night
- Sweatshirt or jacket
- Swimming trunks
- Prescription medication
- Pajamas or sleeping wear
- Towel, shampoo, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush
- Flashlight
- Rain poncho or other rain gear
- Spending money
- Bug spray
- **Water bottle** (water will be provided)
- Sun block lotion
- Completed health form (for both Scout and adults)
- Tennis Shoes (No flip flops, sandals, or open-toed shoes)

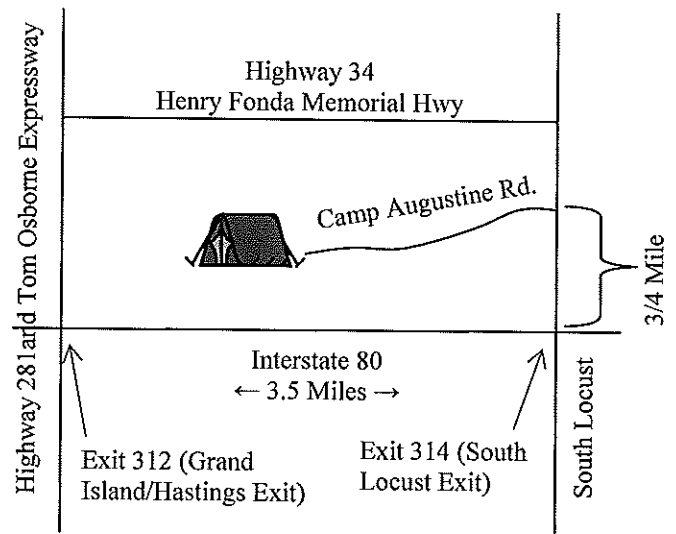
Optional Items to Bring:

- Folding pocket knife (no fixed blades),
- Walking stick
- Camera
- Matches to start a fire
- S'more materials
- Songbook
- Skit Book
- Stories
- Other food items (hot dogs, crackers, etc)
- Lantern
- Sports equipment

What items are not allowed

Firearms, ammunition, bows, arrows, fixed blade knives (knives that don't close), alcohol, drugs, tobacco of any kind, fireworks, electronic devices (CD players, video games, etc.) Be advised that we have had several cell phones and cameras get wet, damaged, or destroyed in the past.

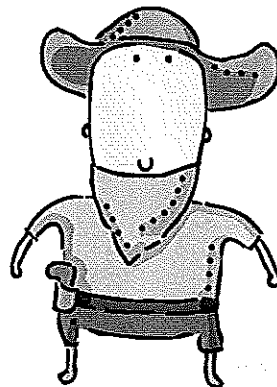
