## UNIVERSITY INFORMATION AND POLICIES

**CHECK-IN:** Check in will begin at 2:00 pm. All participants are required to check in at the Stuhr Museum, 3133 West Highway 34, to receive your weekend unit information packet. We ask that you send one representative from your unit to the registration area to avoid congestion.

**CAMPsites:** If you are camping on the museum grounds you will be assigned a campsite at the time of check-in. After your campsite has been assigned, you will be allowed to take one vehicle into the campground to unload gear. No vehicles or unit trailers will be allowed to stay in the campground area and will be required to return to the designated parking area. Please advise us of any physical limitations we should be aware of (C-PAP).

**Please note:** 1) open flames of any kind are NOT permitted, 2) we are camping on an open prairie, to help protect tent floors it is recommended that you place a tarp or ground cloth under each tent and 3) follow the practices of "Leave No Trace".

**CAMPUS MAPS:** Maps of Stuhr Museum and Central Community College can be found on our web page.

**SHOWER FACILITIES:** Upon request shower facilities are available for participants to use at Camp Augustine.

**OTHER OVER-NIGHT LODGING:** If you or your unit would prefer to stay at a hotel/motel, please contact the Hall County Convention and Visitors Bureau, 308-382-4400, or visit their website: [www.visitgrandisland.com](http://www.visitgrandisland.com) for a list of facilities. **TWO DEEP LEADERSHIP:** BSA requires all units to maintain at least two deep leadership. Each unit will be required to provide this during the entire weekend event. One adult attending must be at least 21 years of age and registered with the BSA. **All adults accompanying Scouts during the university weekend must complete an MBU Leader Registration form and pay all associated fees.** Each unit will be asked to provide a list of adults who will be in attendance for the weekend during check-in.

**UNIT LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES:** Adult leaders of Scouting units are responsible for monitoring the behavior of youth members and interceding when necessary. We ask that leaders attend merit badge class sessions to assist the counselors with any behavior issues that may arise so that the counselors can concentrate on the Merit Badge requirements.

**PROVISIONAL SCOUT ATTENDANCE:** There are instances when Scouts may wish to attend Merit Badge University without their Troop. Since it is our desire to serve as many Scouts as possible, the Merit Badge University committee will find a Troop to host any Scout wishing to attend MBU. The Scout will be required to provide their own tent and necessary equipment. If you are attending Merit Badge University and would like to stay with a host Troop please complete the Provisional Scout Registration Form. If a troop is interested in hosting a "provisional scout" please contact the Overland Trails Council Office @ 308 382-3717.

**SIBLINGS:** Scouting is a family organization and siblings are welcome to attend. Siblings can participate in MBU activities and explore Stuhr Museum during Merit Badge class sessions. Parents must supervise children that attend Merit Badge University. Please indicate the number of siblings attending on your MBU Troop Registration Summary.

**EMERGENCIES & ACCIDENT REPORTING:** All medical emergencies must be reported to staff at the First Aid Station. EMT's will be on staff throughout the week-end to handle any medical emergencies. All accidents even those not requiring medical attention should be reported to staff at the First Aid Station.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation will be furnished to participants taking classes at off-site locations. **Scouts taking classes off-site are required to use the provided transportation.** The Merit Badge University's Tour Permit only allows vehicles and drivers which have been pre-authorized to drive to off-site Merit Badge class locations.

Transportation is not included to the Saturday night offsite activities. Each unit is responsible for getting their scouts to these activity locations and returning them to Stuhr Museum. Please include this information on your units tour permit.

**TOUR PERMITS:** Tour Permits are required by all attending the MBU. Overland Trails Council units please submit your Tour Permit with your registration forms. All other Councils please submit to your Council for approval. Tour Permits will be required to be turned in at check-in.

## MERIT BADGE CLASSES AND AVAILABILITY

**MERIT BADGE SESSIONS:** The OTC Merit Badge University has scheduled two (2) Merit Badge sessions on Saturday and one (1) Merit Badge session on Sunday morning giving Scouts the opportunity to earn up to three (3) Merit Badges during the weekend. Scouts should select four (4) Merit Badges but will be scheduled for three (3). The alternate fourth Merit Badge will only be used if there is a scheduling conflict or class cancellation.

**MERIT BADGE SELECTION:** Refer to the workbook web page at [www.overlandtrailscouncil.org](http://www.overlandtrailscouncil.org) for Merit Badge courses being offered at Merit Badge University. If a workbook is not on the web page then the Merit Badge is not being offered.

**MULTIPLE SESSION MERIT BADGES:** The following Merit Badges require all three sessions to complete. Scouts wanting to earn one of the Merit Badge's will not be able to earn any additional merit badges during the weekend.

- Climbing
- Composite Materials

Additional Merit Badges may be added to this list as Merit Badge requirements are reviewed. Please check the workbook webpage for any changes.

**MINIMUM AGE MERIT BADGES:** The following Merit Badges are open to Scouts 14 years and older:

- Automotive Maintenance
- Citizenship in the World
- Climbing
- Composite Materials

**HORSEMANSHIP, GOLF & SKATING:** The horsemanship, golf, & skating merit badges require some degree of proficiency before being able to complete the merit badge requirements, novices will not be able to complete some requirements and additional practice will be required.

**SCOUT CPR AND FIRST AID RED CROSS CERTIFICATION: THIS IS NOT THE FIRST AID MERIT BADGE CLASS THIS IS FOR RED CROSS CERTIFICATION.** Red Cross Child/Adult CPR Certification and Red Cross First Aid Certification is available for Scouts age 14 and older to complete during Merit Badge class sessions. Scouts can register for one or both of these courses. Indicate the course or courses that the Scout would like to complete on the MBU Scout Registration Form.

**SCOUTS PER CLASS:** Only five (5) Scouts from one troop may sign up for the same merit badge during the same session. If there is a higher demand for a particular subject, we will try to accommodate more Scouts with additional counselors. However, if you really want to take a class, register EARLY, since registrations will be accepted on a "first-come, first-serve" basis and many subjects are limited.

**CLASS CHANGES:** Scouts cannot make changes to their Merit Badge class selections after the June registration deadline. New class selections are subject to class availability.

**MBU CLASS CANCELLATION:** The Merit Badge University committee reserves the right to cancel a class due to low registration or loss of Merit Badge Counselor. Notification will be sent to Scouts and Leaders as soon as a cancellation determination is made.

## **MERIT BADGE WORKBOOKS**

*The Overland Trails Council Merit Badge Workbooks should not be used as a substitute for Merit Badge Pamphlets that are published by the Boy Scouts of America.*

*They are intended to compliment not replace the use of the Merit Badge Pamphlets.*

The Overland Trails Council publishes its own Merit Badge Program Workbooks and requires the use of these workbooks. Workbooks can be printed by going to the Merit Badge Workbook page at [www.overlandtrailsCouncil.org/MBU](http://www.overlandtrailsCouncil.org/MBU). Workbooks are current as of the printing of this catalog. If the Boy Scouts of America updates any requirements before the University Weekend the Workbooks requirements will be updated online.

### **BEFORE THE WEEKEND:**

1. Print off a copy of Merit Badge Workbook
  - a. Complete Part 1 (pre-requisites)
  - b. Complete Section A (Personal Information) on Application for Merit Badge found at the end of the Merit Badge Workbook
  - c. Unit leader signature on Section B on the Application for Merit Badge
2. Review Merit Badge Pamphlet

### **MERIT BADGE UNIVERSITY WEEKEND – SCOUTS RESPONSIBILITY**

1. Bring Merit Badge Workbook, part one and two  
Bring photos, letters of approval or response and any additional materials to help document pre-requisite work
2. Application for Merit Badge with Sections A and B completed  
If your Council requires a “Blue Card” then the Scout will be responsible for bringing it to class
3. Merit Badge Pamphlet
4. Any additional items listed on the “Bring to Class” section of the workbook
4. Pencil or Pen

If a Scout loses or does not have a workbook, a replacement copy will be available for purchase before class from the Trading Post.

## **MERIT BADGE PRE-REQUISITES**

The workbooks have been divided into two parts. Workbook Part 1 (pre-requisites) will not be completed during the weekend class session. It is recommended that Part 1 be completed prior to the University weekend in order for the Scout to get the most out of the experience. Some pre-requisites will lend themselves to being completed after the weekend and will be noted in the workbook. Workbook Part 2 (Class Curriculum) will be completed in class during the university weekend.

### **BLUE CARDS--MERIT BADGE APPLICATION AND RECORD SHEET**

The Application for Merit Badge (blue card) can be found at the end of every respective Merit Badge Program Overview and Workbook. Scouts must complete Section A (Personal Information) of the Application for Merit Badge and the Unit Leader must sign Section B on the form to indicate that Workbook Part 1 (pre-requisites) have been completed and/or the Scout is qualified to begin working on the Merit Badge listed.

At the end of each merit badge session, the merit badge counselor will sign each individual Scout’s Application for Merit Badge (blue card). This will be the Scout’s record of the requirements completed

during the class and should be returned to your Troop's Advancement Chairman. The University will retain an attendance sheet of every merit badge session to verify that a Scout attended the class.

**ATTENDANCE:** Scouts will need to sign an attendance sheet at the beginning of every class. It will be the Scout's responsibility to affirm his presence in class.

**IF YOUR COUNCIL REQUIRES THE USE OF OFFICIAL BLUE CARDS IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SCOUT TO BRING A COMPLETED BLUE CARD WITH THEM TO THEIR MERIT BADGE CLASS. THE COUNSELOR WILL SIGN OFF ON THE BLUE CARD AT THE END OF THE MERIT BADGE SESSION.**

### **MERIT BADGE COUNSELORS**

It is the policy of the Merit Badge University and the Overland Trails Council not to release Merit Badge Counselor information. Questions about Merit Badge classes may be directed to the council office at 308-382-3717.
